## MASTER AND SLAVE CLOCK SYSTEMS

## MAINTENANCE

- 1. CANCELLATIONS. POWER Bldg Svs H 5210
- 2. GENERAL.
- 2.1 The responsibility for maintaining master and slave clock systems rests with maintenance staff as follows:
- (1) In Telephone Exchanges:
  - (a) systems with up to 12 slave clocks: Telephone Exchange technicians
  - (b) systems exceeding 12 slave clocks:
    Master clocks Telephone Exchange technicians

Sub-transmitting units, slave clocks and slave clock wiring
- Workshops Electrical staff or Telephone
Exchange technicians as directed by the
Engineer.

(2) In P.O. Buildings other than Telephone Exchanges: Workshops Electrical staff

- 3. MAINTENANCE.
- 3.1 Master Clocks. See TELES Auto B 5017, 5051, 5210, 5220 and 5517.
- 3.2 Slave Clocks. Clean and lubricate at 5-yearly intervals.
- 3.2.1 Before lubrication remove all dirt and dirty oil.
- 3.2.2 Apply one drop of oil, S.L. No. KAl<sub>4</sub>3, to each pivot, post or pin of the slave clock.
- 3.2.3 Do not apply oil to ratchet wheel, driving ends of the pawl and the brass pin forming the forward stop of the driving pawl.
- 3.2.4 Following lubrication, check all slave clocks for satisfactory operation before the system is recommissioned. Connect a 1.5 volt cell to the clock which should operate satisfactorily as contact is made and broken. If there is any doubt about the operation of a particular clock, check that it operates satisfactorily between the test current limits laid down in BLDG SVS Time D 3210.
- 3.3 <u>Sub-Transmitting Units</u>. Clean and check for satisfactory operation at 5-yearly intervals.
- 3.3.1 Units installed in other than P.O. occupied premises are not covered by this instruction.
